HO'OKIPA TERRACE

Named after the Hawaiian word for "hospitality," Hoʻokipa Terrace is Oʻahu's liveliest gathering place and home to Hawai'i's favorite restaurants and bars offering food and fun for all tastes. Relax and enjoy live local music, celebrate a special occasion or dance the night away.

Highlights include **Tsukiji Fish Market and Restaurant**, which offers an impressive buffet spread consisting of sushi, sashimi, teppanyaki, and traditional Japanese, Chinese, Hawaiian, and Korean dishes. The restaurant also allows patrons to dine at sushi, yakitori or robatayaki bars. The **Mai Tai Bar** is a longtime local favorite for casual after-work drinks, live music, and late-night parties. **Tanaka of Tokyo** features Master teppanyaki chefs preparing vegetables, Certified Black Angus sirloin, imported lobster tails, shrimp, scallops, and more on tabletop grills.
